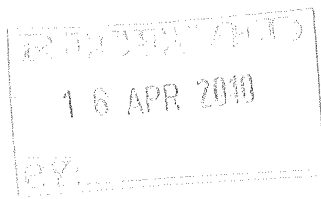


Review of income Policy

As a foreign born NZer. I have a few issues with the Superannuation in NZ.

1. Where does it state that because I lived and worked in the Netherlands and payed taxes + superannuation contributions, here for I get cut while I retire in NZ. I have worked and lived in NZ for 40 years now, still work parttime and still pay my tax.
2. Information supplied by applying for the superannuation, is not good enough. You do not supply full information that you have to apply for the Netherlands superannuation and get deducted.
3. The letter from the Premier Minister of NZ, that I am entitled to 66% of the minimum wage, and after 10 years living here you are entitled to the full pension entitlements. So where does it come in people get cut for it.

I am not the only one, some do it that way. Not here for I just would like it to be sorted out.

As for bringing or inviting 65+ to NZ, does not work, because they would not go to a country where the language is different, and is more expensive, in rural areas there is no the care or public transport.
